Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles; beads may fracture. If frozen, thaw at room temperature. Properly designed equipment is vital if these resins are to be used in conjunction with strong oxidizing agents such as nitric acid to prevent a rapid build-up of pressure and possible explosion.
